The Quiet Wildlife Center

Ava arrived early at the wildlife center to help prepare breakfast for the animals. The rabbit received leafy greens, while the owl waited for a keeper to check its injured wing. Ava noticed that each enclosure was designed differently. The fox had room to explore and hide. The frog had shallow water, damp soil, and broad leaves. Before visitors arrived, Ava wrote down what each animal ate and how it behaved. Her notes helped the keepers notice small changes. When the owl finally stretched both wings, Ava did not assume it was ready to fly. She called the keeper, who checked the wing carefully. Helping animals, Ava learned, required patience, close observation, and respect for their needs.
